MEF Game	For the 2 or 3 year olds, games change a lot depending on the class. Some games are simple passing, free play or working with motor skills that match the children's ability. Some classes are able to play more challenging games more similar to the 3 or 4 year old level.		
MEF Songs	Song1: How are you? Song2: Red, Green Yellow Song3: Fruit Salad Songs are chosen to best match the topics, repeated enough so that children can remember and enjoy the songs, and rotated through the weeks so that the children are getting exposed to many different sentences, new words and review.		
MEF Poster	The Monthly MEF Poster reviews the topics/vocabulary/Alphabet covered that month
